CLOSED SESSION


The Board retired into closed session at 2:07 p.m. to discuss threatened litigation pursuant to Government Code §54956.9(b) – One Case.

Payment of Invoice for Yuba River Levee Repair Project

Recommended Action:


Recommend the Yuba County Auditor/Controller pay the invoice submitted by Nordic Industries, Inc., for Yuba River Levee Repair Project for the period from October 21, 2004 – November 15, 2004.

Discussion:

TRLIA contracted with Nordic Industries, Inc., to construct improvements along a portion of the Yuba River Levee. The contract calls for payment based on unit prices and quantities of materials used to perform the work. Those quantities are subject to verification by HDR Inc., which is under contract by TRLIA to manage the construction project. The attached invoice has been review and approved for payment by HDR and the County's Public Works Director.

Fiscal Impact:

Payment for this invoice is \$283,095 out of a budgeted amount of \$1,745,000. Previous invoices totaling \$1,287,855 were approved for payment on November 9, 2004. Funding for the invoices is paid from prepayments made by developers for levee improvements in-lieu of special taxes approved under the formation of the Community Facilities District for levee improvements.

Agreement for Legal Services with Downey Brand

Recommended Action

1. Authorize Executive Officer to negotiate an extended agreement with Downey Brand for legal services pertaining to the State Reclamation Board encroachment permit and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regulations pertaining to flood zone designations and criteria.

2. Authorize Auditor-Controller to pay legal invoices totaling \$17,727.13

Reason for Recommended Action

In order to continue our efforts to finance and construct levee improvements, legal services are needed pertaining to the State Reclamation Board encroachment permit and FEMA's approach to flood zone designations in the South Yuba Basin Area.

Discussion

The Authority agreed to hire Downey Brand for legal services at its December 14, 2004 meeting up to an amount of \$15,000. Billing to date has exceeded that amount by \$2,727.13. Consequently, Authority action is needed to approve payment above the \$15,000 limit established on December 14th. In addition, staff requests Authority approval to negotiate an agreement providing sufficient funds for legal work over the next several months. If approved, this amended agreement would come back to the Authority for approval later this month.

Fiscal Impact

Any additional costs for legal services will be paid out of developer fees currently available in Trust Fund 805.
