This memorandum provides information regarding the annual escalation of the Three Rivers Levee Fee per the Revised Three Rivers Levee Fee Nexus Study (Nexus Study) dated October 13, 2008 adopted by Ordinance No. 1465 by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors on November 18, 2008.

In accordance with the Nexus Study, the fee is made up of these three components:

- Allocated Cost of Levee Improvements;
- Finance Charges; and
- Fee Administration Charges

Based upon the adopted Nexus Study, the fee will escalate based upon the following:

- An annual rate of 4.5% for the allocated annual costs based upon the Fee Nexus Study; and,
- An annual rate of the change in CPI All Urban Consumers for San Francisco – Oakland – San Jose for the administrative component of the fee.

The fee last escalated on July 1, 2017 by the prescribed escalation rates. The attached **Table 1** provides a summary of the escalated fee expiring on June 30, 2018 and the escalated fee rate for the coming year based upon the prescribed annual escalation provisions outlined within the Nexus Study.

The Nexus Study outlines a process for updating the fee on an annual basis commencing July 1, 2009 and annually thereafter. Therefore these escalated fee rates are effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.
