Amendment number 3 to the Contract, entered into by and between the State of California, acting by and through the Department of Water Resources, herein referred to as the "State" and the Three Rivers Levee improvement Authority, a joint powers agency in the County of Yuba, State of California, duly organized, existing, and acting pursuant to the laws thereof, herein referred to as the "Funding Recipient," which parties do hereby agree as follows:

- A. STD 213, Standard Agreement, and paragraph two is hereby amended to extend the contract term by two years. The termination date is extended from June 30, 2014 to June 30, 2016. The term of this Agreement shall begin November 28, 2006 and terminate on June 30, 2016.
- B. All other terms and conditions of contract # 4600008049, including amendment 1 and 2, shall remain the same.



## ADDENDUM TO EXHIBIT A

### SCOPE OF WORK

#### Funding Agreement between the State of California, Department of Water Resources and the Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority (TRLIA)

This Addendum modifies the Scope of Work in Amendment No.2, Exhibit A, by rescheduling tasks necessary to complete the Feather River Levee Improvement Project (FRLIP). These rescheduled tasks do not increase the total cost of the project.

**Tab C: Modified Schedule shown by Project Element and Features (Am-2, Addendum to Exhibit A, Attachment 2)**

Tab C: Modified Schedule shown by Project Element and Feature is hereby replaced in its entirety by the updated schedule attached as FRLIP Am-3 Addendum to Exhibit A, Attachment 1. The contract end date is now June 30, 2016. The reasons for the time extension are described below per task.

**Element 1: Land Acquisition (see real estate acquisition plan for details):**

Feature 1.1 – Feather River Segment 2: The completion of property acquisition documentation necessary for state ownership has proved to be challenging. Also, there are multiple distinct planned projects in the setback area that are anticipated to lead to different land transfer dates for the properties. The anticipated land transfer dates for the various land uses require the funding agreement to be extended to June 30, 2016, to complete this task.

Feature 1.2 – Feather Segment 3: The completion of property acquisition documentation necessary for state ownership has proved to be challenging. The anticipated land transfer dates for the various land uses require the funding agreement to be extended to June 30, 2016, to complete this task.

**Element 2: Feather River Segment 2 setback levee w/o tie-ins, new levee construction requiring federal action (except as noted in features):**

Feature 2.1.2 – Permitting: In summary, permitting activities for Segment 2 include:

TRLIA participation in the DWR Lower Feather River Corridor Management Plan: The Lower Feather River Corridor Management Plan is still in draft format and needs to be finalized and approved by DWR. This plan impacts the way TRLIA will manage and transfer the Feather Setback area (Element 6).

Feature 2.1.3 – Right of way support for real estate acquisition (see real estate acquisition plan): This feature needs to be extended to support the completion of Project Element 1, Feature 1.

Feature 2.4 – Environmental & Cultural Mitigation: Until the Feather River Setback area property is transferred to the state, TRLIA will remain responsible for these sites.

**Element 5: Feather River Segment 3 levee improvement:**

Feature 5.1.3 – Right of way support for real estate acquisition (see real estate acquisition plan): This feature needs to be extended to support the completion of Project Element 1 Feature 2.

**Element 6: Feather River Land Management:**

Until the Feather River Setback area property is transferred to the state, TRLIA will remain responsible for the property. The transfer of the property to the state is anticipated to be done by June 30, 2016 (see Project Element 1 Feature 1). All Features need to be extended (Environmental Maintenance Activities, Lease back activities (e.g. farming), and Land Maintenance of Setback Area (e.g. Security, etc.)).

**Element 7: Project Management, legal support, community relations support, land management support, and overhead:**

All Features of this Element need to be extended to June 30, 2016, to support the completion of all other elements.

**Element 8: Feather River EIP Land Acquisition (see real estate Acquisition Plan for details): Added to Work Plan by Amendment 1 – was Associated Project Element 1:**

Feature 8.1 – Feather Segment 1: The completion of property acquisition documentation necessary for state ownership has proved to be challenging. The anticipated land transfer dates for the various land uses require the funding agreement to be extended to June 30, 2016, to complete this task.

**Element 9: Feather River Segment 1 levee improvement: Added to Work Plan by Amendment 1 – was Associated Project Element 2:**

Feature 9.1.3 – Right of way support for real estate acquisition (see real estate acquisition plan): This feature needs to be extended to support the completion of Project Element 8 Feature 1.

**Element 10 (Added by Amendment 2): Closeout Process post June 30, 2012:**

Feature 10.1 – Closeout Process post June 30, 2012: This Project Element and Feature needs to be extended to June 30, 2016, to support project completion.
