We have received your application for a Central Valley Flood Protection Board permit for the following work:

**Description:** To transplant approximately 34 elderberry shrubs, within a 1.4 acre area, and plant additional associated species into an existing mitigation site, approximately 23 acres, (Anderson Site) on the overflow area of the left (east) bank levee of the Feather River.

**Location:** The project is located south of Marysville and west of Anderson Avenue. Section 23, T14N, R3E, MDB&M (Reclamation District 784, Feather River, Yuba County)

If you find any discrepancies between the works you are proposing and what is described above, please notify the Board at 3310 El Camino Avenue, Room 151, Sacramento, California, 95821, immediately, in writing. Please be advised that the proposed project cannot begin until your application has been approved and a Board permit has been granted to you. If we determine that additional information is needed, we will notify you within 30 days.

If any person files a protest to your application, we will send a copy of the protest to you and ask you to respond to the issues raised in the protest.

Since January 1, 2008, the Board has been required to hold an evidentiary hearing for any matter that requires the issuance of a permit. The hearing will be held under Section 13 of the Board's regulations and the procedures in Chapter 4.5 of the Administrative Procedures Act, starting with Section 11400 of the California Government Code. The formal procedures of Chapter 5 of the Administrative Procedures Act will not apply. You will be given the opportunity to be heard and to present and rebut evidence. If there are no protestants to your project and Board staff considers it to be a minor project, the Board may put your item on its consent calendar and act based on the staff report and

evidence you have presented to staff.
