MINUTES – BOARD OF DIRECTORS

JUNE 6, 2006

A meeting of the Board of Directors of the Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority was held on the above date, commencing at 3:35 p.m., within the Government Center, Marysville, California, with a quorum being present as follows: Directors Rick Brown, Mary Jane Griego, and Richard Webb. Construction Access Easement/Frances Hofman: Following a recap of condition requirements for access easement from Ms. Frances Hofman and Board and staff inquiries, Ms. Hofman advised she would allow Nordic Industries continued access through July 13, 2006 and would return to the Authority meeting this date for a response to unanswered questions including who bears the cost of the access easement. No one came forward.

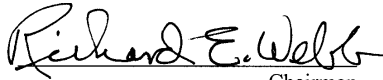
RECESS
