MINUTES - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SEPTEMBER 5, 2006

A meeting of the Board of Directors of the Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority was held on the above date, commencing at 3:30 p.m., within the Government Center, Marysville, California, with a quorum being present as follows: Directors Rick Brown, Dan Logue, and Richard Webb. Director Mary Jane Griego was absent. Also present were Executive Director Paul Brunner, County Counsel Daniel Montgomery, and Clerk of the Board of Supervisors/Secretary Donna Stottlemeyer. Chairman Webb presided.

PUBLIC COMMUNICATIONS

Director Logue requested letters to Senator Sam Aanestad and Assemblyman Rick Keene thanking them for their efforts regarding levee funding.

CONSENT AGENDA

Minutes: Upon motion of Director Logue, seconded by Director Brown, and carried with APPROVE Director Griego being absent, the Board approved the minutes of the regular meetings of MINUTES August 8 and 15, and special meeting of August 29, 2006, as written.

DISCUSSION ACTION ITEMS

River Partners/\$4,276,800/Environmental Restoration/Bear River Project: APPROVE Following a recap from Executive Director Paul Brunner regarding funding contract AGREEMENT payment and Board inquiries, upon motion of Director Logue, seconded by Director Brown, and carried with Director Griego being absent, the Board approved a contract with River Partners for an amount not to exceed \$4,276,800 to perform environmental restoration near the Bear River and setback levee, and authorized the Executive Director to execute same contingent upon review and approval of Counsel and subject to negotiated terms and funding sources.

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Loan Repayment/\$331,000/Yuba County Water Agency: Following a recap from Executive Director Paul Brunner regarding loan repayment and Board inquiries, upon REPAYMENT motion of Director Logue, seconded by Director Brown, and carried with Director Griego being absent, the Board approved repayment of a 2004 loan from the Yuba County Water Agency in the amount of \$331,000 for Phase One Problem Identification Study by May 2007.

APPROVE

Following a recap from County Counsel Daniel Montgomery regarding the approval of ADD TO the loan repayment, terms of loan approved August 29, 2006, and Board inquiries, upon AGENDA motion of Director Logue, seconded by Director Brown, and carried with Director Griego being absent, the Board added to the agenda the approval and execution of loan agreement with Yuba County Water Agency and Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority in the amount of \$2 million.

Upon motion of Director Logue, seconded by Director Brown, and carried with Director AGREEMENT Griego being absent, the Board approved the loan agreement between the Yuba County Water Agency and Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority in the amount of \$2 million and authorized the Chairman to execute as amended to recital numbering.
